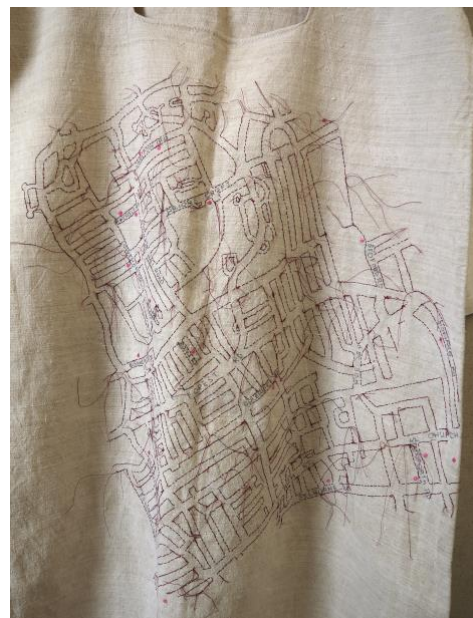

Threading Time/ Laundresses & Char Women



My mother died when I was young and, with her, any connection to her side of the family – I am embarrassed to say I didn't even know my grandmother's name. I had no photos, no documents, no mementoes.

Family history research revealed sad tales of recurring loss, hardship and broken connections. Many of my women ancestors – laundresses, char women, and maids – were dead, widowed or institutionalised while still in their 30s.

Trousseau is a collection of antique linens and a census-style document in a vintage laundry box that traces their paths through the streets of Walthamstow and east London. It is a family portrait of sorts.

These were strong, resilient women and I have told their stories using simple hand stitching. It is women's work, manual labour, but it was a privilege to sit and spend time with them this way.

Times & Places

I will be showing *Trousseau* at two venues during E17 Art Trail 2019:

- First under the banner of *Threading Time* as part of an Open House with **Lynda McDonald** – a local textile artist who explores the state of the natural world through stitch.
- In the final week, I will be showing at **Vestry House Museum**. It is where I researched some of my ancestry, aided by the helpful and knowledgeable archives team. My research is ongoing.
